The role of Maria is taken by Ivy Munnerlyn (24 Hour Musical). Town newcomer Becky Loar brings wisdom and guidance as the Mother Abbess with Ashley Alvarado (Jekyll & Hyde) and Joel Yarborough (The Music Man) adding dimension as the filthy rich baroness Elsa Schraeder and greedy Uncle Max. Nathan Jackson (The All Night Strut) and Lee Saxton (Grease) share the role of Rolf who introduces young love and, ultimately, betrayal.
