Bringing extra holiday spark are our talented dancers: Agnes Babb (*Nine to Five*), Ashley Epperson (*The All Night Strut!*), Christy Shealy Mills (*Mary Poppins*), Zanna Mills (*Bright Star*), Kristy O'Keefe Satterwhite (*Mamma Mia!*) and Kendall Scruggs (*Anything Goes*). Bill DeWitt (*Moon Over Buffalo*) serves as our show's emcee.

Town's youth theatre student groups, the Town Tweens and Town Teen Troupe (T3), elevate the excitement of the holiday festivities. Special guests returning "home" include Josh Finch (*Big Fish, Beauty and the Beast*), Nathan Jackson (*Elf: The Musical, The Sound of Music*), Lee Martin (*Hairspray, Hello, Dolly!*) and Kerri Roberts (*West Side Story, My Fair Lady*).
