Emily Clelland (*The Red Velvet Cake War, Hello, Dolly!*) takes on the role of Annelle, Truvy's shy and quirky assistant. Gayle Stewart (*Nice Work If You Can Get It*) plays the wealthy, witty widow, Clairee. Kathy Hartzog (*Always, Patsy Cline, Driving Miss Daisy*) charges in as Ousier, the salon's curmudgeon who barks louder than she bites. Debra Kiser, returning to the Town stage after last being seen in *Kiss Me, Kate* in 1979, brings strength as M'Lynn. Zanna Mills (*The Play That Goes Wrong, Bright Star*) portrays her daughter, Shelby. Each flower in Town's bouquet brings unique charm and strength to the stage, creating a tapestry of love, laughter and resilience.




