## **The Audition Process**

We believe the process of auditioning is an important tool for our actors to learn and incorporate into our curriculum. However, because this is a class, ALL students are cast in the show. Please keep reading below so that your student can be as prepared as possible for this process.

## Monday and Wednesday students (grades K to 4th)

- Please complete and bring the student's AUDITION FORM with you to your first class.
- Students will complete their entire audition during their first class.
- It will include vocal work, movement and reading from a script. If a student has trouble with reading, we will make sure they have a fair chance while auditioning.

## **The Rehearsal Process**

Students enrolled on Mondays or Wednesdays will have a more relaxed rehearsal process in comparison with the older classes. They will learn several songs that will be performed during the show which will be performed with choreography.

In addition to the songs within the show, students will also be rehearing a material to serve as our pre-show.

With a smaller workload for this class, we are able to take more time to develop necessary skills in theatre. The skills and lessons that we teach in class go far beyond the stage. Students will learn how to work as a team, develop listening and comprehension skills, grow their confidence, and enhance their ability to learn new things each week.

Starting March 24, the younger and older classes will join to work on the show altogether. On some occasions, the younger class will be dismissed early but please plan on your student being there the whole time unless otherwise stated.
