Rounding out the parfumerie team are Ethan Wilson (*Beauty and the Beast*) as the affable Ladislav Sipos, Rich Fisher (*White Christmas*) as the steadfast Mr. Maraczek, and Tommy Osburn (making his Town debut) as the eager Arpad Laszlo.

We are also thrilled to introduce ensemble members Nicholas Baden, Joanne Ferster, Christi Fletcher, Grace Kenderine, Lauren Sudduth and Stephanie Villamizar, all making their Town Theatre debut. 


